



1880 Façade

This beautiful façade, constructed of solid oak (frames, panels and mouldings), dates from 1880. All the display pipes are made of zinc and are painted 'gold'.

In 1957, when the original organ was moved and rebuilt, the case was enlarged by adding the panels on either side of the smaller pipe towers. These can be easily removed or can be incorporated into any relocation as necessary.

Overall, it measures approximately 25 feet wide by 22 feet high. The middle pipe tower is approximately 15 feet high. The façade supports its own full weight, however, it is not a free-standing structure.

It is in excellent condition, but currently is in storage.
