



1908 Façade

This façade (approximate width of the case is 20 ft.), is from a 1908 Casavant Frères Ltd. pipe-organ from a church that was destroyed by a passing tornado. It incorporates painted and finely decorated display pipes of zinc, utilizing gold-leaf highlights.

It was the visible part of a very mellow and beautiful sounding 'Romantic' instrument, whose voicing has not been altered in any way since its installation.

This façade, in conjunction with the pipework from the same instrument, (see Item N° 3 - 1908 Pipework for a 3-manual Romantic pipe-organ), can be incorporated into a rebuilt pipe-organ with modern components (console, switching and combination action, winding, etc.), yet retain its turn-of-the-century sound quality and ambiance.
